Executive Summary Report on DR. CHUNG SIK YONG'S VISIT TO THE PHILIPPINES

I. Introduction

Dr. Chung Sik Yong (former Continental Director of Asia Pacific), appointed by Dr. Joon Ho Seuk as the Chairman of the World Tong-Il Moo-Do Federation (WTMF) visited the Philippines on November 12, 2025 after five years. Dr. Yong's itinerary official scheduled visit on November 13-15, 2025) was chronologically arranged to visit three key Islands of the Philippines: Firstly, the Mindanao Island (South), secondly the Visayans Island (Middle South & North) via Zoom (online) conference, and finally at Luzon Island (North).

II. Overview

From November 13 to 15, 2025, Dr. Chung Sik Yong, Chairman of the World Tong-II Moo-Do Federation (WTMF), conducted a strategic, inspirational, and mission-driven visit to the Philippines, accompanied by Dr. Venus G. Agustin, EVP and Secretary-General of WTMF.

The visit strengthened nationwide Tong-Il Moo-Do (TIMD) engagement, inspired current and future practitioners, and intensified preparations for the upcoming 40-Day TIMD International Training Workshop to be held on February 1 to March 12, 2026 in Cheongpyeong, South Korea.

III. November 13, 2025 – Luzon Engagement with FFWPU Leadership

This report presents the summary of key events, messages, and strategic directions shared by Dr. Yong during his visit and meeting with selected Philippine leaders. His guidance focused on the current situation in Korea, the mission of True Mother, reflections on True Father's course, and the global development of Tong-II Moo-Do (TIMD).

At 2:20 PM, Dr. Yong arrived and was warmly welcomed by selected leaders from the Philippines. Upon arrival, he proceeded to Cheonshim Won, where he offered a solemn Kyeongbae and prayer.

The formal program commenced at 3:00 PM, beginning with a welcoming message delivered by Dr. Julius Malicdem. Thereafter, after Dr. Venus Agustin gave an introduction with video presentation, introduced Dr. Yong officially to deliver his keynote speech. Dr. Yong emphasized the importance of Cheonshim Won, established by True Mother, as a unifying spiritual foundation for members worldwide.

Dr. Yong shared that many Korean members, including his own children, have been inquiring about True Mother's current situation, reflecting deep concern and longing for her stability and well-being. He also recalled his most recent encounter with True Mother at the Namhyangju Church, where she spoke for 40–50 minutes. He noted that this was a rare and significant moment, offering profound inspiration and guidance.

Dr. Yong reflected on his recent experience in Las Vegas, where he gained deeper understanding of True Father's course and the challenges he faced in that environment. He highlighted a key teaching of True Father: "If you want to restore Las Vegas, you need to know Satan. You need to understand what is happening in Las Vegas." This, he explained, underscores the importance of understanding the spiritual realities and challenges within any mission field.

Dr. Yong expressed his strong support for Tong-II Moo-Do (TIMD) as a powerful and effective witnessing tool for the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU). He stated his intention to collaborate closely with President Hori to further develop and strengthen TIMD programs worldwide.

Dr. Yong also encouraged Dr. Venus and Dr. Bernard to work collaboratively with FFWPU leadership to ensure that TIMD is fully integrated into witnessing activities and youth engagement strategies. A major highlight of Dr. Yong's message was his announcement of a global initiative to bring 120 TIMD practitioners from various nations to Korea for a comprehensive International Instructors Training Workshop, scheduled for:

In a demonstration of his strong commitment, Dr. Yong mentioned officially that through the WTMF IHQ will cover the registration fees (food and accommodation) for all the participants but each participants round-trip ticket is SELF-SUPPORT. He expressed that this initiative serves not only to develop future TIMD leaders but also to strengthen global unity and uplift young people across many nations.

Dr. Yong further acknowledged the Philippines' exemplary contribution to the advancement of TIMD. He highlighted the success of the "Zero to Hero" 120-Day Project, noting that it remains a model of dedication, discipline, and transformational impact.

Dr. Yong's visit provided valuable spiritual guidance, strategic direction, and renewed encouragement for the leaders and members of the Philippine movement. His emphasis on strengthening Cheonshim Won-centered faith, enhancing witnessing through Tong-II Moo-Do, and advancing global youth development reflects a visionary path forward.

The Philippines' continued leadership in Tong-II Moo-Do serves as a strong foundation for future international initiatives, including the 2026 TIMD instructors training program in Korea. Dr. Yong delivered a powerful Tong-II Moo-Do orientation, reflecting on his historic "Zero to Hero" Project, previously co-hosted by the International Peace Leadership College (IPLC) and WTMF—Philippines.

The orientation, attended by FFWPU Headquarters leaders, staff, and Tong-Il Moo-Do masters, reaffirmed TIMD as a peace-centered martial art with a global mission and renewed commitment to raising 30,000 qualified TIMD instructors.

Upon arrival in Davao City, Dr. Yong and Dr. Agustin were warmly welcomed by the couple of Master Cyrus Tumanda at the Davao International Airport. The delegation immediately visited the TIMD Dojang of Gregorio "Jun" Presores to recognize his passion and dedication and encourage the ongoing development of TIMD in the area.

Before traveling to Tagum City, the team held a cordial courtesy meeting with Regional Director Ronnie Sodusta and his Moshim team at Daleachoius Café, Davao City. Dr. Yong once again presented TIMD's long-term vision to raise 30,000 instructors as a foundation toward Olympic-level recognition. The impression and responds of everyone to Dr. Yong's guidance was well absorbed and understood align to the goal of bringing result through TIMD creating an environment for witnessing and educating the youth.

The group then proceeded to Tagum City, where hotel accommodations and meals were generously sponsored by the couple of Master Cyrus Tumanda, ensuring a smooth and hospitable experience.

V. November 15, 2025 – Training, Recruitment, and Youth Engagement

The morning session (8:00–10:00 AM) brought together TIMD black belts and visiting martial artists from Karate and Muay Thai Kickboxing. Dr. Yong provided a clear explanation of TIMD's mission, global vision, and long-term objectives. Each participant was formally invited to join the 40-day international training in 2026.

Master Rafael De Leon, representing a Japanese Karate school, was deeply inspired by the vision of Tong-Il Moo-Do (TIMD) and committed to participate in next year's 40-days TIMD international training and partnership workshop - reflecting TIMD's growing cross-disciplinary reach.

Later in the day, the delegation visited Gaisano Mall (G-Mall) to meet the TIMD students of Master Tumanda's couple. Young practitioners and their parents enthusiastically awaited and warmly welcome the visitors' arrival (Dr. Chung Sik Yong and Dr. Venus Agustin).

A spirited TIMD demonstration followed, showcasing discipline, teamwork, confidence, and determination among the youth. Dr. Yong delivered a heartfelt message of hope - one that resonated deeply with students, parents, and leaders - emphasizing the mission to bring joy and victory to True Mother Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon.

After the GMall event, the couple of Master Tumanda along along with two TIMD instructor brought us to visit the existing TIMD dojang. We visited the 1ST TIMD dojang in the house of Master Cyrus Tumanda which was managed by his sister Elrose Tumanda and later visited also the 2ND TIMD dojang which was manage by Jocelyn Brazil at the back of Municipal Hall of Asuncion lead by Jocelyn Brazil. Both Master Tumanda, her sister and Joscelyn are graduates of the International Peace Leadership College (IPLC).

VI. Success of Nationwide Zoom Meeting – Engaging the Visayas Region

As part of the nationwide mobilization effort, a highly successful online Zoom meeting was conducted with TIMD officials and key leaders from the Visayas region. During the meeting:

Dr. Venus G. Agustin delivered a dynamic presentation that highlighted the success of the Zero to Hero Project, showcasing memorable TIMD video demonstrations and recalling the triumphant graduation of the 120-Day TIMD Training Workshop at IPLC.

Dr. Chung Sik Yong candidly presented an inspiring vision of TIMD, highlighting its role in peace-building, character development, and future global expansion. He strongly encouraged all Visayas chapters to send delegates to the 40-Day TIMD International Training Workshop in Cheongpyeong, emphasizing that this training is essential in fulfilling the worldwide goal of nurturing 30,000 instructors.

The meeting fostered unity, renewed enthusiasm, and clear direction for TIMD leaders in the Visayas, ensuring strong support for upcoming national and international activities.

VII. November 16, 2025 - The Final Trailblazing Itinerary of Dr. Yong at SHIA, Luzon Island

On November 16, 2025, the chairman of World Tong-il Moo Do Federation, Dr. Chung Sik Yong had successfully conducted a special gathering with Philippine Tong-il Moo Do blackbelts (27 participants) at Sun Hwa International Academy. Dr. Yong clearly emphasized and boldly reminded the participants of the strong vision of Tong-il Moo Do and its character education that has high impact to the young people as the hope of the future generation.

In addition, Tong-il Moo Do is internally an effective tool for a productive witnessing environment in the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification and externally, it can help in the society through connecting to other martial arts and to the government. It can also train and raise future instructors with good financial stability in the future.

Meanwhile, Dr. Venus G. Agustin gave a brief report regarding the upcoming 40-Day Tong-il Moo Do International Training and Partnership Workshop to be held in Cheong Pyeong Training Center, Gapyeong, South Korea on February 1- March 12, 2026. Its vision is to raise 30,000 World Tong-il Moo Do Instructors within 5 years with the Theme, "The Way of Loyalty and Filial Piety is the Foundation to Win Over Everything." The target goal will be 120 Blackbelt delegates from all continents.

With the great inspirations that the participants received, they gave their individual insights and reflections regarding to Tong-il Moo Do in their own daily lives as well as their determination towards accomplishing their portion of responsibility through giving their best support to Tong-il Moo Do Providence in the country most especially to Heavenly Parents and True Parents.

Therefore, all attendees (they) are committed to make strategical planning in order to revive and develop their own areas of responsibility as well as to encourage their regional instructors, co-black belts and friends from other martial arts to attend the said workshop in Korea. With this, the Tong-il Moo Do League of Blackbelts Incorporation officers will gather the list of TIMD Blackbelts and make a core group who will be joining special workshop.

It is truly important to have vision, carry that vision, have belief in God then miracles can happen even in the midst of such tribulations. It was such a great time having the elder and younger blackbelts uniting in victory with Dr. Chung Sik Yong who gave tremendous inspiration and motivation to everyone. The special meeting ended with great hope and victory for Tong-il Moo Do Providence. It was indeed a day filled with passion and determination in reviving and advancing the Tong-il Moo Do providence in the Philippines.

VIII. Conclusion

Dr. Chung Sik Yong's three-day visit to the Philippines achieved several strategic and providential outcomes:

- 1) Strengthened national and regional structures of WTMF-Philippines
- 2) Mobilized Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao leaders in unified action
- 3) Sparked fresh excitement through the successful Visayas Zoom meeting
- 4) Inspired cross-discipline engagement among martial artists
- 5) Reinforced preparations for the 40-Day TIMD International Training Workshop
- 6) Uplifted youth practitioners & parents through heartfelt guidance and TIMD demonstrations
- 7) Advanced the global vision of raising 30,000 Tong-Il Moo-Do instructors
- 8) WTMF IHQ will cover the food and accommodation for each participants but each round-trip ticket is SELF-SUPPORT.

The visit of Chairman Dr. Yong to the Philippines significantly contributed to TIMD's national growth, solidified unity among TIMD leaders, and advanced the movement's providential mission toward becoming a globally recognized martial art for peace - and ultimately, an Olympic sport in the future.


